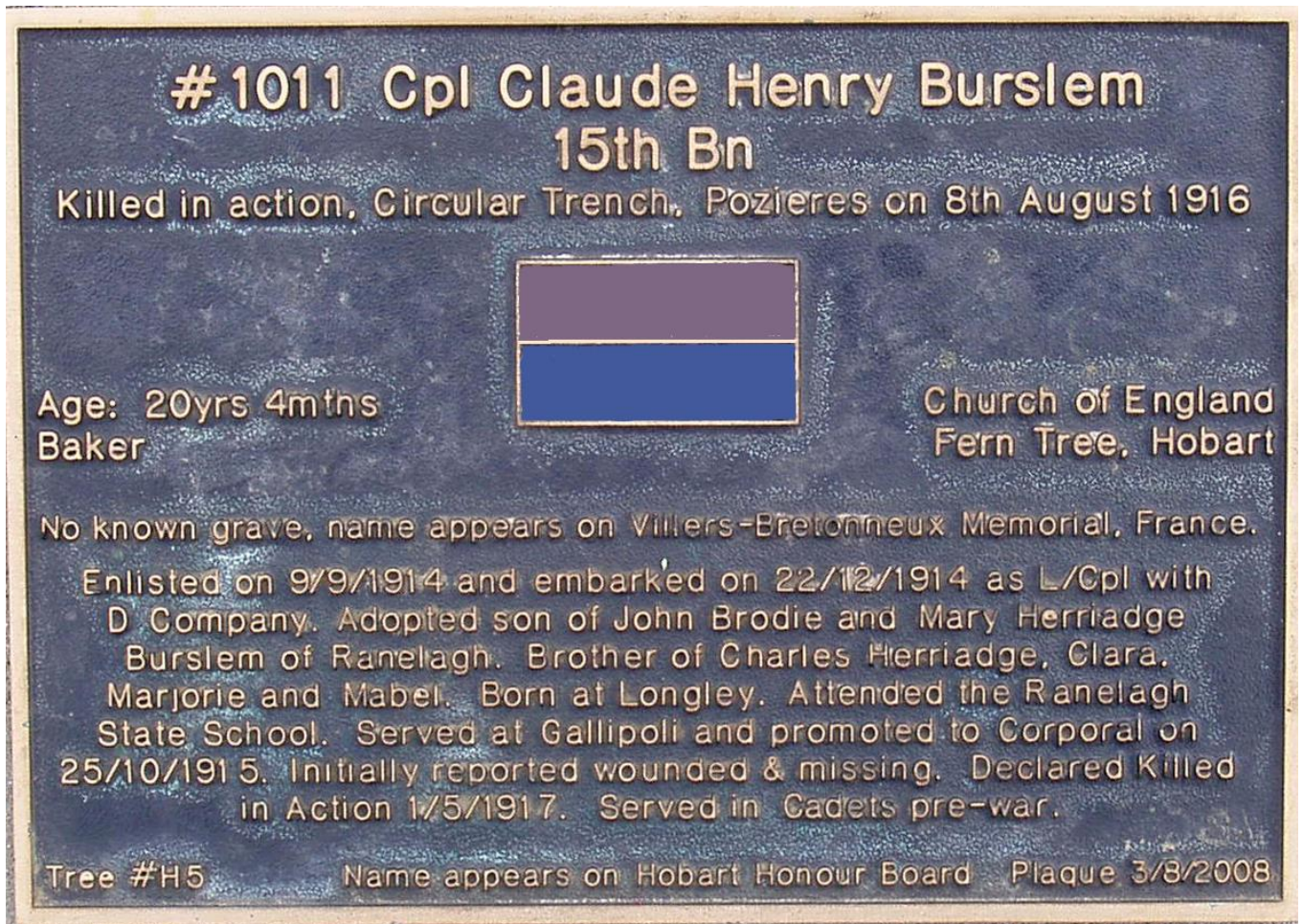




Soldiers Avenue Plaque, Queens Domain, Hobart, Tasmania, commemorating the Great War 1914-1981 fallen

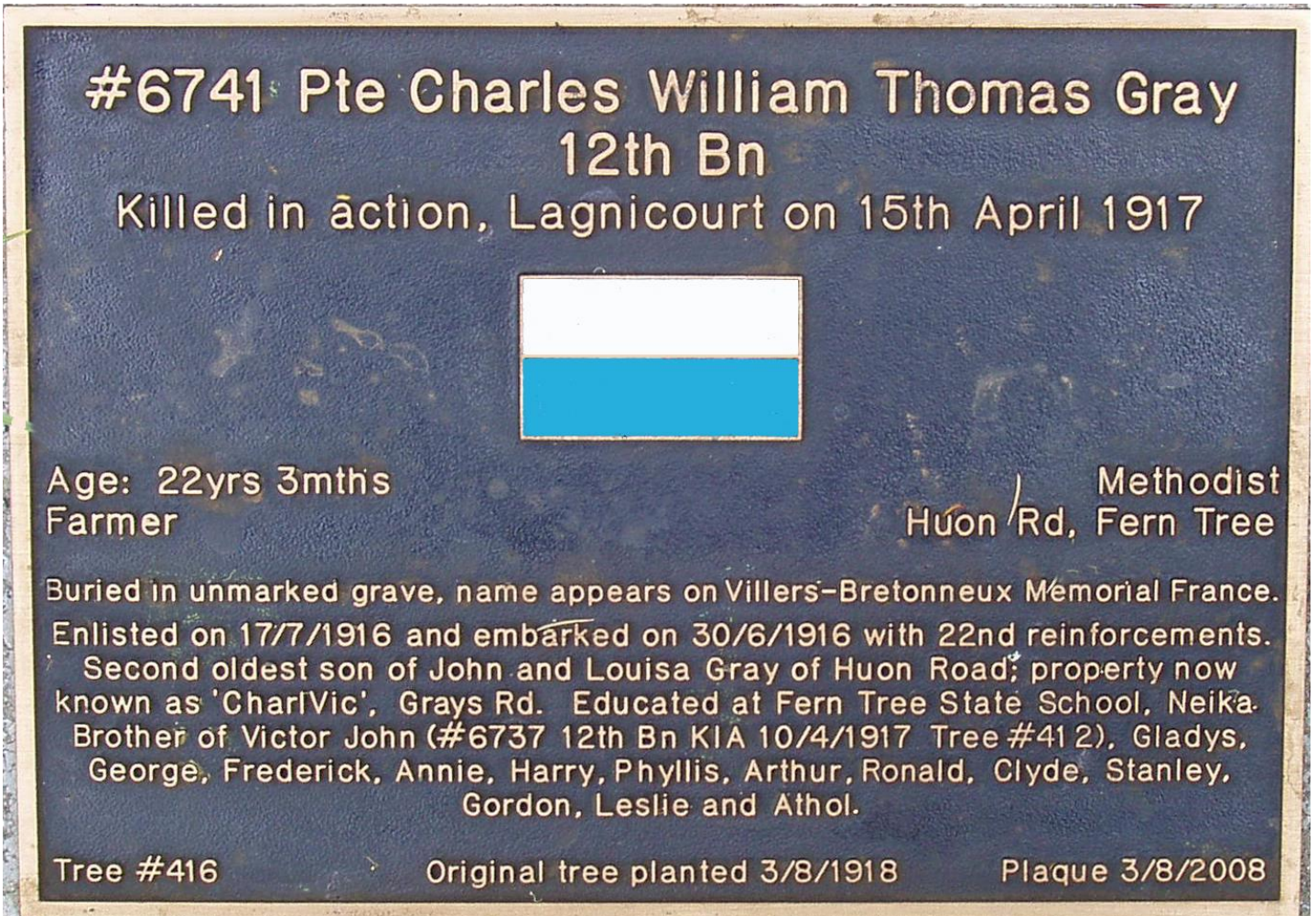

Buried in Bapaume Australian Cemetery, France

Drawn for service in NZEF, Wellington NZ in May 1916. Returned to Tasmania to enlist 5/7/1916 with younger brother Charles William Thomas (#6741 12th Bn, KIA 15/4/1917, Tree #416). Embarked 30/9/1916 with 22nd Reinforcements. Served in France December 1916 until April 1917. Mortally wounded in early morning assault on Boursies 8/4/1917. Died 3rd Australian Casualty Clearing Station. His headstone epitaph is 'Love and Remembrance Last Forever'. Oldest child of John and Louisa Gray of Huon Road, Fern Tree. Educated at Fern Tree State School, Neika. Older brother of Charles, Gladys, George, Frederick, Annie, Harry, Phyllis, Arthur, Ronald, Clyde, Stanley, Gordon, Leslie & Athol. Engaged to Marion (Marie) Hurn.

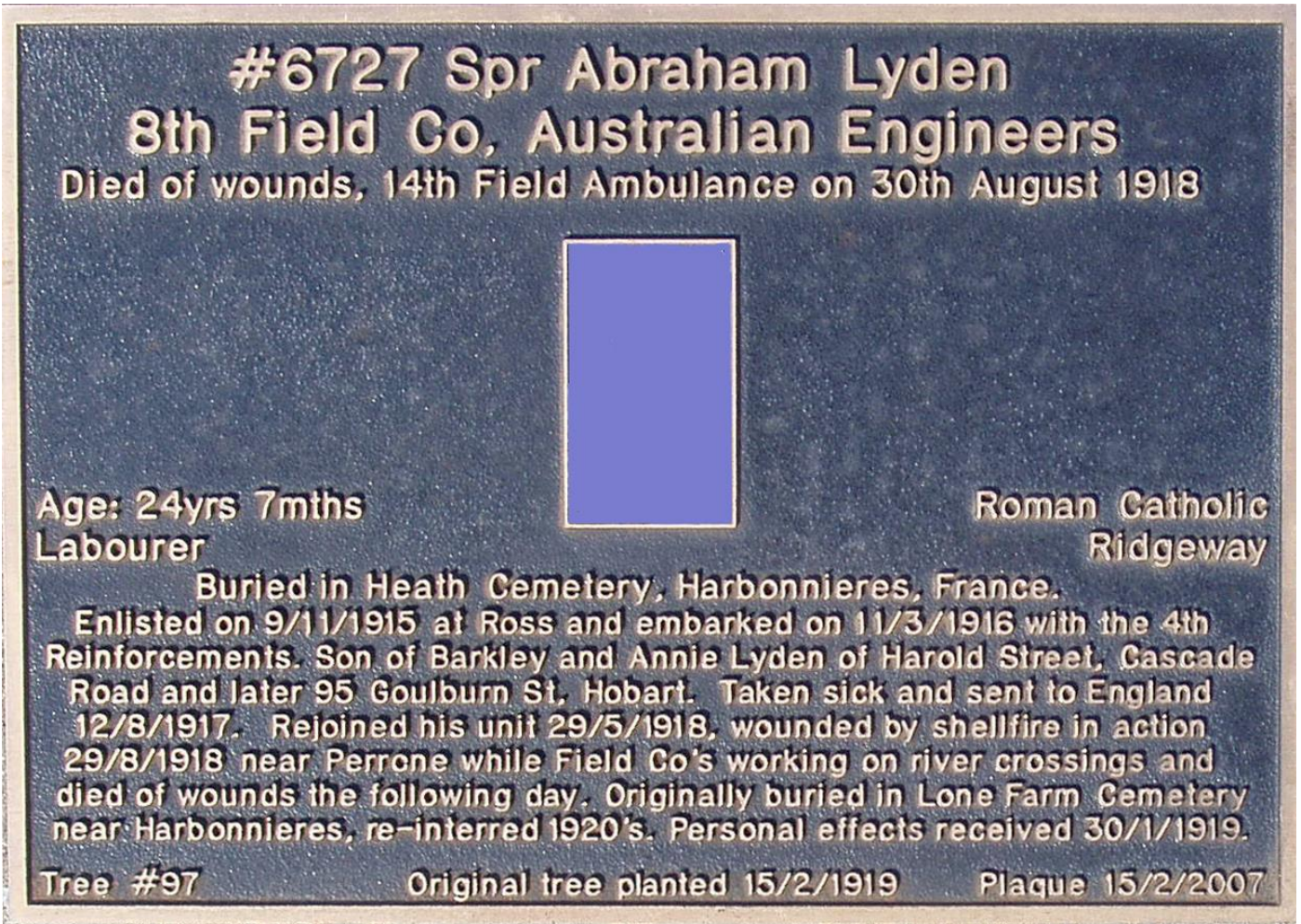

No known grave, name appears on Villers - Bretonneux Memorial, France
Enlisted 1/6/1916, embarked with 20th Reinforcements 24/8/1916. Born in
Leesdon Hall, Staffordshire to Edward John and Laura Jane Charles. Brother
of Lt. Percy Charles (R.F.C.), Nurse Elsie Charles (C.A.M.C.) William Charles
(Royal Bedfordshire Rgt.), Mrs William Keith and Mrs. James Brough (Alberta,
Canada). Educated in England and Canada. Family lived in Hobart while
Edward Charles managed construction of Waterworks. Killed instantly during
night raid near Malt Trench. Body buried by relieving battalion. Grave lost.
Father helped to prepare and plant his tree.

Name also appears on Hobart Town Hall Honour Board.



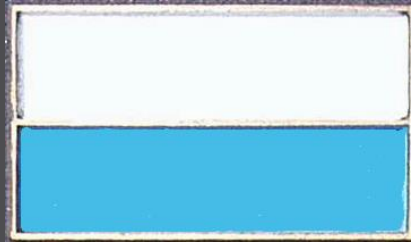

Enlisted 10/02/1915, embarked with 5th Reinforcement 17/04/1915. Born in Hobart Tasmania to Charles and Margaret Seymour of High Peak, Huon Road, Neika. Brother of Dvr. Thomas Charles (1 Coy AASC).

Final posting 3rd Trench Mortar Battery.

Regimental No. 2063 Embarked 17/04/1914 from Melbourne on HMAT A20 *Hororata*.
Name does not appear on the Municipality of Kingborough honour roll in the Kingston Beach Hall;
neither do the other 5 Neika residents who volunteered and who did return.
